Dear Mr. President,

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1822 (2008), adopted by the Security Council on 30 June 2008, concerning the Al-Qaida and Taliban sanctions regime. In paragraph 39 of this resolution, the Security Council decided to extend the mandate of the current New York-based Analytical Support and Sanctions Monitoring Team for a further period of 18 months. The Council also requested me to make the necessary arrangements to this effect.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that I have re-appointed the following six experts for a period ending 31 December 2009. Efforts are being made to identify a replacement for the two remaining experts who have resigned from their functions as of 22 and 30 June 2008, respectively. Once these candidates have been identified, I will take the appropriate action.

I have also selected Mr. Barrett to continue to serve as the Coordinator of the Monitoring Team.
