This is in response to your request of your letter dated 23 December 1993, in respect to clear Major Beardsley, of UNAMIR.

The Instructions of my Army Headquarters still stands that nobody should be crossing any border crossing point from UNAMIR to UNOMUR HQS until further notice. The route to be used is only ENTEBBE.

Please be informed that with effect from today 24 december 1993 nobody will be allowed to cross from KIGALI to KABALE or KABALE to KIGALI until I receive other instructions.

You are therefore requested not to seek any clearance until the matter is sorted out by high authorities.

Your usual maximum cooperation is highly appreciated.

Subject : UNOMUR/ NRA OPERATIONS GUIDELINES

Refer to previous guidelines dated 22 november 1993 I have found it necessary to make additional items for the smooth running of our operations.

1. Movement between Kampala and Kabala v.v:
All UNOMUR observers going to and from Kampala must have an escort of NRA. Arrangements of providing an escort anytime are already in place.

2. Katuna-Check point two:
There has been reports of checking personnel and identity cards at Katuna by UNOMUR observers. This should stop. Refer to Mission Agreement, the observers should check for Arms, Ammunition and any other material that could be of military use.

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THE STATIC OP/CP AT CYANIKA AND KATUNA CONTINUE TO BE MANNED ON A 24/7 BASIS. NOTHING IMPORTANT HAS BEEN FOUND AFTER OUR THOROUGH SEARCHES OF VEHICLES THAT CROSS INTO RWANDA AT KATUNA. THE OP/CP AT LUBIRIZI IS STILL UNDER CONSTRUCTION AND FROM THE LOOK OF THINGS, IT MIGHT BE READY FOR PERMANENT OCCUPATION BY THE END OF THIS MONTH OR MAYBE EARLY NEXT MONTH.

(3) PATROLS

THE DCMO, COO, AND AREA EAST OPERATIONS OFFICER CONDUCTED THE VERY FIRST BOAT PATROL ON LAKE BUNYONYI ON 31 DEC 93, HOWEVER, THE NRA CHIEF LO SEEMED A LITTLE APPREHENSIVE, ARGUING THAT THE LAKE WAS NOT ON THE COMMON BORDER WITH RWANDA. AREA EAST PATROLS HAVE CONTINUOUSLY FOUND FRESH TRACKS COMING FROM A NRA CAMP IN THE LUBIRIZI - KASHEKYE AREA GOING ACROSS INTO RWANDA THROUGH MBALE. THE NRA HAVE BEEN INTERVIEWED BY OUR MILOBS IN CONNECTION WITH THE MATTER, BUT THEY HAVE REFUSED THE FACT. OUR DAY AND NIGHT PATROLS CONTINUE TO BE CONCENTRATED IN THE AREA, AND ALSO IN THE BIGAGA AREA.

AREA WEST PATROLS HAVE BEEN MAINLY CONCENTRATED IN THE BORDER AREAS OF LAKE CHAHAFY, NKURUNGURU AND LUGENDABARE BUT NOTHING SIGNIFICANT HAS BEEN DISCOVERED. OUR HELICOPTER PATROLS HAVE NOT TAKEN OFF THE GROUND SINCE WE ARE STILL AWAITING THE ARRIVAL OF THE HELICOPTER(S) ON 07 JAN 94 AS EARLIER PROMISED.

C. RELATIONS WITH NRA

OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH NRA IS GOOD. THE BIGGEST PROBLEM STILL REMAINS THAT THEY DON'T HAVE THE LOGISTICS TO SUSTAIN OUR OPERATIONS - AND AS SUCH - WE HAVE HAD TO CONTINUE CARRYING THEM ON UN CARS WHEN GOING OUT ON PATROL.

4. POLITICAL

IN THE REPORTING PERIOD, A HIGH POWERED BURUNDI DELEGATION VISITED UGANDA AT THE INVITATION OF PRESIDENT MUSEVENI. THE DELEGATION IS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN EXCHANGING VIEWS ON THE POLITICAL AND SECURITY SITUATION IN BURUNDI. SEE UNOMUR INTSUM FOR PERIOD 26 DEC 93 TO 02 JAN 94.

5. ADMIN AND LOG SUPPORT

THE COMMS REPEATER STATION RECENTLY INSTALLED, IS NOT SUFFICIENTLY COVERING THE WHOLE OPERATIONAL AREA. THERE IS A NEED FOR A SECOND REPEATER STATION. ONCE INSTALLED, YOUR HQ WILL BE INFORMED ACCORDINGLY. LAST WEEK WE COULD NOT COMMUNICATE UNAMIR HQ BY TELEPHONE, MAYBE DUE TO BAD TELEPHONE LINES. ALSO, RADIOS INSTALLED IN OUR 4X4 CARS HAVE TO BE RE-PROGRAMED IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE PROPER COMMUNICATIONS THROUGH THE REPEATER/RELAY STATION. THE NECESSARY TOOLS FOR

THE RE-PROGRAMMING SHOULD BE SENT TO US AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

6. LIAISON, CONTACTS AND MEDIA

UNOMUR STAFF (BOTH THE MILITARY AND THE CIVILIANS) ORGANISED A SUCCESSFUL NEW YEAR'S EVE PARTY AT WHICH THE IMPORTANT LOCAL AUTHORITIES WERE INVITED. THE OCCASION HAPPENED IN A VERY RELAXED ATMOSPHERE AND WOUND UP WITHOUT ANY INCIDENT.

7. OBSERVATIONS

SINCE WEEKLY SITREP No 06 FROM UNAMIR HQ, WE HAVE NOT GOT ANY FURTHER INFORMATION ABOUT THE DEVELOPING AND/OR OVERALL SITUATION IN RWANDA. WE WISH TO BE KEPT ABREAST OF THE SITUATION BECAUSE OF ITS INFLUENCE ON OUR OPERATIONS. WE WOULD BE MOST GRATEFUL TO RECEIVE THE INFORMATION REGULARLY.

Sir,

1. In the past concerted efforts were made to NRA authorities to provide assistance to UNOMUR based on the agreement forged between the United Nations and Ugandan Government itself. This issue was further pursued as shown at Reference A with the relevant Government officials. A letter at reference B was produced to emphasize the need and urgency of the matter.

2. Understanding the difficulties that all countries are facing, particularly on financial matters, we were insistent that a peace meal approach be instituted in acquiring/providing the support. UNOMUR has patiently waited for the NRA to prepare itself for this goal. As of now, the NRA has only provided 5 officers and 80 other ranks, positive but far from being adequate.

3. On the logistical support side only 3 landrovers have so far been provided, in the exclusion of other essential items which we strongly feel should be part of log package - for example communications equipment, vehicles, tentage and fuel (current fuel allocation per month is 2000 Lts, require approximately 7500 Lts per month). A complete breakdown of NRA requirements is stated in Annex A.

4. The role that the NRA is currently carrying out in support of UNOMUR is so vital yet if it is not carried according to the laid down norms it may cause problems. The principle is that, the NRA should be self-sustained i.e. it must have its full log back up. In some cases, we had to contravene the UN standing orders by transporting NRA soldiers in UN vehicles as a necessity, putting our own position on impartiality at stake. This is by all standards unacceptable

5. Numerous requests were also made to the NRA high authorities for the provision of information on minefields laid along the 150 Km border on the Ugandan side, where UNMOs conduct foot and vehicle patrols, so far no feedback has come forth, we desperately need this information for planning purposes.

6. Once again, your cooperation will be greatly appreciated.

OBJET:

On the basis of the information collected during the recent field review in Uganda/Rwanda by the Compensation and Classification Service, the Officer-in-Charge of Human Resources Management has approved the following conditions of service applicable to the mission:

- (a) The mission has been designated as a special and a non-family mission in accordance with staff rule 103.21;
- (b) The mission area has been defined as Uganda/Rwanda for administrative purposes;
- (c) Under staff rule 103.21, the following MSA rates have been approved for mission personnel throughout the mission area with effect from the date of deployment of Phase I of the mission:
 - (i) First 30 days in mission area - \$137
 - (ii) After 30 days in mission area - \$85
- (d) The above MSA rates are subject to supplements of 10 and 25 per cent for staff in the D-1/D-2 and ASG/USG levels, respectively. They are payable in U.S. dollars;
- (e) MSA is payable for periods of annual leave and compensatory time-off accumulated in the mission area within the prescribed limits wherever they are taken;
- (f) The first 30 days rate of MSA is applicable to the members of the Phase I reconnaissance team until such time as they are redeployed from Kampala to Kabale/Kisoro, as well as to the liaison staff to be posted in Kampala for the duration of their assignment in that specific location;



I ABSOLUTELY AGREE WITH THE SENTIMENTS EXPRESSED BY THE DCMO IN THE ATTACHED MEMORANDUM. THE SECURITY OF MY MILITARY OBSERVERS AND THE ENTIRE UNOMUR CIVILIAN STAFF SHOULD BE TREATED AS PRIORITY, AND CANNOT BE IGNORED, FOR DOING SO WOULD BE BLINDLY RUNNING AWAY FROM MY OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES. BECAUSE OF THE UNSTABLE SECURITY SITUATION IN UGANDA AS A WHOLE, ALL UN PERSONNEL ARE AWARE THAT THE NRA PROVIDES ESCORTS IN THE OPERATIONAL AREA AND THE REAR (KAMPALA) AND ANYONE WHO IS NOT FOLLOWING THIS INSTRUCTION IS DOING SO AT HIS OWN PERIL. HAVING SAID THAT THEREFORE, IT BECOMES CLEAR THAT MOVING FROM KISORO TO KABALE IS AN OPERATIONAL NEED, JUST AS MUCH IT IS OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENT TO MOVE FROM KABALE TO KAMPALA. WE MUST UNDERSTAND THAT WE ARE DEALING WITH AN ABNORMAL SITUATION, WE SHOULD THEREFORE BE EXTRA CAREFUL THE WAY WE HANDLE THE SECURITY ASPECT.

ALTHOUGH THIS SUBJECT WAS DISCUSSED IN THE PAST WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS, WE STRONGLY FEEL THAT IT SHOULD BE HANDED TO YOU FOR A SOLUTION.



Subject : Shuttle service Kampala - Kabale v.v.

1. In the briefing for all UNOMUR personnel held by Bgen Dallaire on the 16th of October, he stated the following points:
 - a. The operational area is the border with Rwanda between Zaire and Tanzania.
 - b. Kampala will be regarded as rear operation area. It is not allowed to go there with a 4 x 4 vehicle, only in exceptional cases. Leave and CTO, if started with a flight, will start from Kampala. A shuttle service will be established that will go to and from Kampala twice a week. A minibus will probably be bought for this purpose.
 - c. A welfare shop should be started in Kabale to give UNOMUR personnel the opportunity to buy duty free items and prevent them from paying too much to the local shops.
2. In the recce period from August 18th to September 19th the arrangement was made with the NRA that all traffic to and from Kampala required the presence of NRA personnel. For safety and security reasons the NRA insists that all transports were accompanied by their personnel since our safety is their responsibility.
3. For several reasons this agreement has not always been complied with. Because of the lack of transport of the NRA it is still necessary that UNOMUR provides the transport of NRA military escorts.
4. It is my opinion that it is required to tighten the discipline. We should not allow UNOMUR personnel to go to and from Kampala unaccompanied or with local transport. All UNOMUR transport should be provided with a NRA escort.
5. Observers, who are going on leave/ CTO and who are not in the opportunity to use the shuttle, are now obliged to use the local coaches. The drivers of these coaches have a extremely unsafe road going attitude and are continual overspeeding. Recently again a coach had an accident with as result 30 people heavily wounded and some killed. Also these coaches are so overcrowded, that the observers have to fight themselves in to it. I think that we put the observers to unacceptable risks, when they have to use these coaches.
6. For security and safety reasons, moral and personnel care it is necessary to provide a shuttle service twice a week. During these trips the shuttle can also be used for resupply of the duty free shop.

7. I would like to ask you to take this matter up with the our civilien authorities and see if there is any possibi-
lity to comply with the requirements mentioned.



I have discussed the above noted subject with the competent officials of the Ministries of Defence and Foreign Affairs.

While the officials concerned reiterated Government's commitment to respect the agreement governing UNOMUR operations, including the section referring to free movements within the Uganda boundaries, they were of the opinion that the cross border movement was not part of the agreement and should not therefore be treated as part of that agreement. It should be dealt outside the framework of the UNOMUR agreement. The procedures established for the clearance of the movements of UN personnel in or out of the country would be more appropriate.

As far as the Government of Uganda is concerned, the Uganda/Rwanda border is officially open. Hence the Government of

Uganda would see no difficulties in issuing clearance when and if requests are received through the normal channel in order to facilitate cross border movements.

In view of the foregoing, I urge UNOMUR to ensure that the people who are expected to make frequent trips between Kigali and Kabale are issued with multiple VISA. Similarly, the normal procedures be followed to clear movements of equipment and supplies between Uganda and Rwanda. In this connection you are welcome to use the facilities of my office to secure the required clearance.

In conclusion I wish to emphasize that it is important to treat the operations in Uganda and Rwanda as separate entities. As you will appreciate this issue remains to be highly sensitive and it is imperative that UNOMUR's operations reflect that clearly.



Kabale UN peace-keepers in sex scandal

House wives are being used as sex objects by United Nations (UN) peace keepers at the Rwanda border.

The UN team which was deployed in August 1993 to monitor security along the Uganda-Rwanda border and to observe the peace agreement signed between the Rwandese Patriotic Front (RPF) and the Rwanda Government in Arusha, has reportedly committed sex abuses and gone a rampage in the district.

The Monitor has reliably learnt that during the celebrations to mark the 48th anniversary of the founding of the UN on October 24, UN soldiers in Kabale took the opportunity to exchange their money for sex.

The soldiers are said to be using the lure of the United

States dollars to woo married women into sex, for which they pay between US \$ 50 to US \$100 for a woman who often serves about five men.

Information indicates that four women collapsed after failing to contain the lustful soldiers on the anniversary day.

One such glaring example was that of Mrs Grace (husband's name withheld) who reportedly broke down in St. Rafale Rest House on Nyakambu Road after serving four men and finding it difficult to accommodate the fifth. She was given some dollars and later abandoned in the

hotel.

Another dollar-hungry woman, Mrs Robinah (husband's name withheld) was reported to have served six men who threw her out of the hotel room in Victoria Inn Kabale. She fell several times as she staggered to leave the hotel.

In White Horse Inn, the waiters came to the rescue of one Nam and another unidentified woman after the two decided to raise alarms after failing to contain the pressure of the soldiers. The soldiers immediately took off and abandoned the sex workers in one room where they were found weeping.

The victims are said to be wives whose husbands either work in distant places like Kampala or are always on business trips. It is alleged that the UN soldiers prefer married women because they are suspected to be AIDS free. They also use pimps who persuade

people's wives and other different places as "play grounds."

It is said that when the number of women sealing their bodies increased, the soldiers reduced their prices from US \$50 to US \$5 and from US \$100 to US \$10.

Several husbands have reportedly complained to the relevant authorities but in vain. One of them who preferred anonymity told this reporter that he had found his wife in possession of US \$100 which she admitted to have got from the UN soldiers.

This conduct by the UN troops is attributed to redundancy. The RPF is reported to be in Byumba and Ruhengeri districts inside Rwanda and there is no activity along the border.

When contacted on phone in Kabale yesterday, the Political Adviser to the United Nations Monitoring Observer Group (UNMOG) Dr. Karia said that they had received similar reports from the Assistant District Administrator Kabale and local

people.

He said he had conducted an investigation and found the allegations "baseless."

Dr. Karia however admitted that UN soldiers are accommodated in the said hotels.

On what his soldiers do to meet their sexual needs, Dr. Karia said they have a system which was introduced at their mission called Compensatory Time Off (CTO) in which those officers who work two weeks consecutively without a break are given seven days off and are allowed to go out of the mission grounds.

"Those who can't control themselves can use this time but we always respect the norms and traditions of the local people and such acts are not allowed where we operate," he said.

Dr Karia however said that if the allegations are found to be true, action will be taken because the UN wants to work in harmony with the local population.

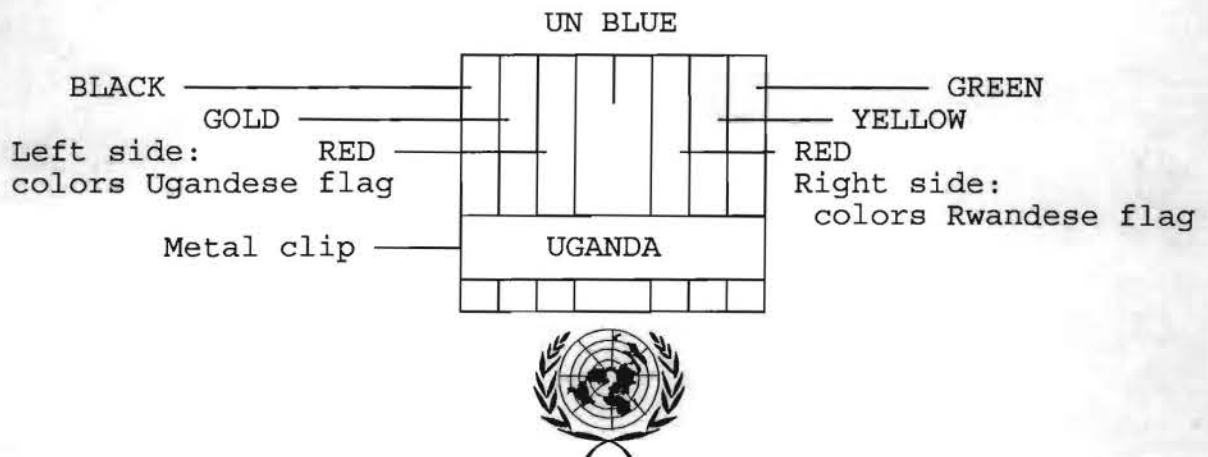

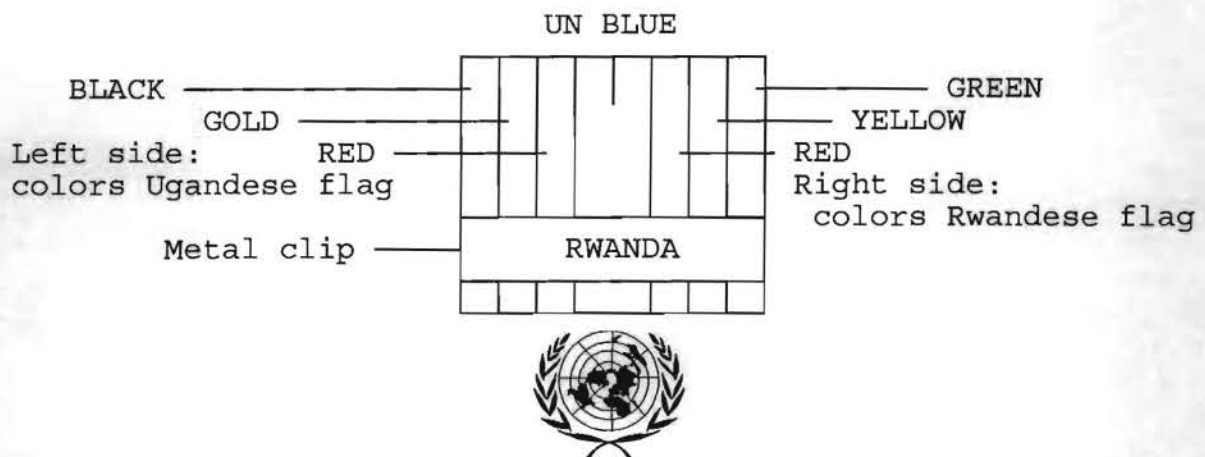

THEREFORE PLEASE FINALISE THE COMPOSITION AND STRENGTH INCLUDING LOGISTICS AND COMMUNICATIONS DETAILS OF THE SAME, ONCE THE RECONNAISSANCE PARTY ARRIVES IN KIGALI IN CONSULTATION WITH THE BELGIAN LIAISON OFFICER AS PER THE UNAMIR GUIDELINES.

4. PLEASE FORWARD YOUR RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE SAME AFTER INCLUDING RELEVANT INPUTS FROM THE RECONNAISSANCE PARTY AND THE BELGIAN LIAISON OFFICER.

IMPUNITÉ DANS L'ASSASSINAT DE Mr. EMMANUEL GAPIYISI

Les journalistes MUSANGAMFURA (ISIBO) et NYIMBUZI (La NATION) qui le jour de son assassinat avaient traité E. GAPIYISI de "jongleur impudent, candidat aux enfers" se complaisent toujours dans l'impunité. Ils ont été punis par les autorités judiciaires.

1. Quatre mois après l'ignoble assassinat de Monsieur Emmanuel GAPIYISI, Président de FORUM PAIX ET DEMOCRATIE, les membres de FORUM PAIX ET DEMOCRATIE et les Amis d'Emmanuel GAPIYISI regrettent que le public ne soit pas informé de l'évolution du dossier, malgré les promesses et les déclarations rassurantes faites par les Premiers Ministres NEENGLIYAREMYE Dismas et UWILINGIYIMANA Agathe et par le Ministre de la Justice NTAMABYALIRO Agnès.
2. Le recours à des experts étrangers décidé par le Conseil des Ministres apparaît finalement comme une manoeuvre démagogique, puisqu'à ce jour, cette décision n'est pas suivie d'effet.
3. Il est fort regrettable que le Procureur Général près la Cour d'appel de Kigali, qui, de par la loi, a la plénitude de l'action publique pour le crime commis sur la personne de Monsieur Emmanuel GAPIYISI, ait préféré se réfugier derrière le Collectif des Ligues et Associations de Défense des Droits de l'Homme au Rwanda (déclaration du 2 juin 1993) pour condamner l'inertie du système judiciaire et l'impunité des crimes, au lieu d'assumer ses responsabilités de supervision et de direction de l'action publique (art. 60 du Code d'Organisation et de Compétence Judiciaires).
4. Les membres de FORUM PAIX ET DEMOCRATIE et les Amis d'Emmanuel GAPIYISI trouvent anormal que les journalistes, qui, à la veille de l'assassinat d'Emmanuel GAPIYISI, le traitaient de "jongleur imprudent" et de "suicidaire", et le jour de son assassinat le désignaient "candidat aux enfers", n'ont pas encore, selon les informations recueillies, été approchés par les enquêteurs.
5. Il est grand temps que les services de police judiciaire, du ministère public et de la Justice en général justifient leur raison d'être, car l'ombre sur tant de crimes commis dans ce pays et l'impunité qui en résulte prouvent qu'ils n'assument pas suffisamment leurs responsabilités.
6. FORUM PAIX ET DEMOCRATIE et les Amis d'Emmanuel GAPIYISI demandent au Gouvernoment, spécialement au Ministre de la Justice, ainsi qu'au Procureur Général près la Cour d'Appel de Kigali, de faire diligence pour expliquer au peuple les difficultés rencontrées et la collaboration éventuelle qu'ils souhaiteraient.

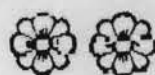

The UNAMIR UN Flag Raising Ceremony at the Sous-Préfecture of Kinihira on Monday 1, November 1993, All Saints Day was the first formal ceremonial but also operational peace keeping activity of the mission in Rwanda. The presence of so many Rwandese Government and Rwandese Patriotic Front Leaders, and the large presence of the local population was most encouraging to the officers and men who are serving in UNAMIR for the secure implementation of the Arusha Peace Process in this magnificent country.

Troops contribution

Confirmation has been received from New York that the bulk of the troops needed for the Phase I of the UNAMIR mission, that is the reinforcing of the DMZ forces and the establishment of the Kigali Weapons Secure Area are identified now. The reconnaissance element of the large Bangladesh portion of the Kigali dedicated Battalion will be here around the 15 November 1993. That country is also providing the Engineer company, a number of UN observers and Headquarters staffs, and the Movement Control element that is also arriving next week.

Experienced personnel

The bulk of the staffs and reinforcement to the DMZ structure are officers who have been moved to Rwanda from their very successful mission in Cambodia (UNTAC). The valuable experience they gained in demobilizing several hundred thousand troops and in supporting a transitional government in Phnom Pen leading to the recent successful elections cannot be neglected. This experienced team is being brought together in UNAMIR in order to maintain the fast pace of implementation for the establishment of the Broad Based Transitional Government as soon as possible.

The Force Commander, BGen Roméo A. Dallaire is most thankful for the generous and warm welcome demonstrated to all the members of UNAMIR on 1 November 1993, at the Flag Raising Ceremony. He hopes that the initial donation of to the UNAMIR Displaced Persons and Refugee Fund will be seen as a sign of our total commitment to the Peace Process of Arusha in all its aspects.

I the undersigned, undertake to avoid any action which may adversely reflect on my status as an UNMO assigned to the United Nations Observer Mission in Uganda and Rwanda or on the integrity, independence and impartiality which are required by that status.

I undertake to observe the following:

- (a) Publication of any material or information, whether or not protected by copyright is forbidden during an UNOMUR assignment, except by the express authorization of the Chief Military Observer;
- (b) Unless specifically authorized by the Chief Military Observer, shall not accept speaking engagements or make statements to or grant interviews with the press, radio, television or other agencies of public information during their assignment with UNOMUR;
- (c) UNMOs shall exercise the utmost discretion in regard to handling of documents, cables, maps or other UNOMUR papers and they shall follow detailed instructions issued by UNOMUR concerning such documentation. In particular, documents, cables, maps or other papers, copies thereof or notes on their contents, may not be taken away from the mission, published or otherwise handled or communicated to others except with the prior approval of the Chief Military Observer in each case;
- (d) Without the prior approval of the Chief Military Observer in each case, UNMOs shall not accept any invitation to visit military or individual installations or to participate in or be present at official ceremonies sponsored by any of the parties in Uganda and Rwanda;
- (e) UNMOs shall follow specific regulations issued by UNOMUR regarding the taking of private photographs and the carrying of private photographic equipment. In particular, UNMOs shall not photograph restricted subjects;
- (f) UNMOs shall follow specific regulations issued by UNOMUR regarding the purchase, import and disposal of duty-free merchandise and shall cooperate with measures taken by UNOMUR to prevent the occurrence of any abuse of privileges or facilities accorded to UNMOs.

I understand that non-compliance on my part with any of the above rules during my UNOMUR assignment may result in my immediate repatriation.

I further recognize that the following rules apply after completion of assignment to UNOMUR and undertake to observe them:

- (a) Publication of any material or information whether or not protected by copyright is forbidden after completion of the Uganda assignment, except with the prior approval of the Secretary-General in each case;
- (b) When UNMOs accept speaking engagements or grant interviews to information media after completion of their assignment with UNOMUR, they may describe the purpose and functions of UNOMUR in general and their daily life in the mission and give previously published data. They shall not discuss any points concerning UNOMUR operations that may have a bearing on relevant issues or divulge information known to them by reason of their work as UNMOs;
- (c) UNMOs after their UNOMUR assignment shall not divulge the content of documents, cables, maps or other papers of UNOMUR, except with the prior approval of the Secretary-General in each case.
