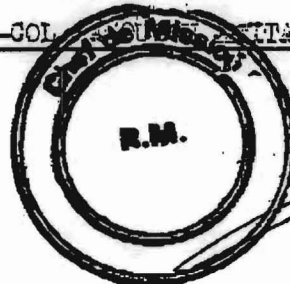

SUBJECT: SHOOTING INCIDENT, KAMEMBE, 04 AUG

1. Attached please find sector 4 Milob report on subject incident.

2. Comment: There appears enough blame on both sides for the escalation, however it should be noted that:

a. with emotions stirred (the breaking of the roadblock and subsequent vehicle chase) the RPA were quite disposed to fire on unarmed UNAMIR troops when they had clearly surrendered themselves. It is surprising that only two people were wounded, possibly the deterrent of VP Kagame's warning against killing UNAMIR troops;

b. emotions are a consideration when dealing with RPA. When heightened, they are likely to be far more aggressive and irrational.

c. the unilateral escalation by Malawi coy (APCs & MGs) brings up the point of another potential problem over who has overall command of the Sector. It is recommended that, with formed troops essentially an "as tasked" unit, that the Milob Sector Commander, the one with the overall view and intelligence over the sector be the overall sector commander. This would also have the additional benefit of clearer reporting and non-duplication of effort.

SUBJ: SPECIAL SITREP NO. 01 AS OF 042200 HRS AUG 95

1. GENERAL. FURTHER TO OUR SITREP OF 04 AUGUST, DETAILS OF THE INCIDENT INVOLVING THE MALAWI COMPANY TROOPS AND RPA SOLDIERS ON 04 AUGUST 95 AT 1330 HOURS, IN THE GENERAL AREA OF KAMEMBE COMMUNE RESULTING IN A TENSE SITUATION, HAS BEEN INVESTIGATED. THE INVESTIGATION WAS CARRIED OUT IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE OCCURRENCE OF THE INCIDENT. THE SEQUENCE OF EVENTS WHICH OCCURRED BEFORE THE FIRING AS NARRATED BY ALL INVOLVED PARTIES AND THEREAFTER OBSERVED WHILE TRYING TO RESOLVE THE ISSUE IS ENUMERATED AS UNDER:

- A. AT APPROX 0900 HRS ON FRI, 4 AUG 95, 2LT STEPHEN KASOMAHU, ID# M 8487, ALONG WITH 50 OTHER SOLDIERS LEFT THE MALAWI COMPANY FOR THE KAMEMBE MARKET. THE SOLDIERS WERE GENERALLY WEARING CIVILIAN ATTIRE, EXCEPT FOR THE OFFICER AND A FEW OTHER SOLDIERS. THERE WERE ONLY TWO WEAPONS IN THE ENTIRE GROUP. AT APPROX 1200 HRS, ONE OF THESE VEHICLES, A "LANDROVER", COMMITTED A TRAFFIC VIOLATION AT THE KAMEMBE MARKET (SPEEDING AND NOT SIGNALLING AT A TURN). THE GENDARME OFFICER, LT PRIVAT GAKWYA IN CHARGE OF THE GENDARMERIE, NOTICED THIS VIOLATION, STOPPED THE VEHICLE AND ADDRESSED THE DRIVER OF THE INFRACTION COMMITTED. THE DRIVER WAS INSTRUCTED TO FOLLOW HIM TO THE GENDARMERIE ALONG WITH THE VEHICLE. 2/LT KASOMAHU WHO WAS PRESENT INTERVENED AND TOLD LT GAKWYA HE COULD NOT IMPOUND THE VEHICLE AND DETAIN THE DRIVER. IN THE MEANTIME, 2LT KASOMAHU WENT TO THE RADIO SET TO COMMUNICATE WITH HIS COMPANY HQ, WHEN THE DRIVER

SUDDENLY SPED AWAY WITHOUT ANY AUTHORIZATION OR ORDER FROM THE OFFICER. THERE WERE 8 SOLDIERS IN ALL IN THE VEHICLE.

- B. THE DRIVER IDENTIFIED AS STAFF SERGEANT NUNDWE, SPED AWAY BREAKING THROUGH THE BARRIER AT THE KAMEMBE PERMANENT CHECK POINT (GR 795253). BY THIS TIME, THE RPA HAD GIVEN CHASE FROM THE KAMEMBE MARKET AND WAS IN FULL PURSUIT OF THE MALAWI VEHICLE DRIVEN BY SSGT NUNDWE. THE RPA PATROL IN A NISSAN VEHICLE WAS LED BY LT GÉRALD NTARUGERA, RPA LIAISON OFFICER (LO), WHO ATTEMPTED TO OVERTAKE THE MALAWI VEHICLE APPROX ONE KILOMETER FROM THE KAMEMBE CHECK POINT (GR 805253), ON THE ROAD TO SHAGASHA. THE CO-PASSENGERS OF THE VEHICLE TOLD THE SSGT TO STOP FOR FEAR OF BEING FIRED UPON BY THE RPA WHO HAD ALREADY TRAINED THEIR WEAPONS ON THE MALAWI VEHICLE.
- C. THE MALAWI SOLDIERS CAME OUT OF THEIR VEHICLE AFTER THE VEHICLE HAD CAME TO A FULL STOP AND SUBSEQUENTLY RAISED THEIR HANDS. WHILE THE MALAWI SOLDIERS ALLEGE THAT THEY WERE FIRED UPON WHILE ON THE MOVE, THE RPA LIAISON OFFICER ALLEGES THAT ONCE THE MALAWI VEHICLE FINALLY CAME TO A STOP, A SCUFFLE ERUPTED BETWEEN THE TWO PARTIES DURING WHICH THE RPA RESORTED TO FIRE IN THE DIRECTION OF THE SOLDIERS. THE RPA LO THEN FIRED DIRECTLY AT THE SOLDIERS WITH HIS PISTOL HITTING ONE OF THE SOLDIERS ON THE HAND WHILE ANOTHER RPA SOLDIER FIRED HIS AK-47 HITTING A MALAWI SOLDIER ON THE LEFT THIGH.
- D. AFTERWARDS, 2LT KASOMAHU ARRIVED ON THE SCENE FROM THE KAMEMBE MARKET SOME 3-5 MINUTES AFTER THE SHOOTING INCIDENT AND FOUND HIS TWO WOUNDED SOLDIERS LYING ON THE ROAD PAVEMENT. THE RPA LO CAME TO THE VEHICLE AND POINTED HIS PISTOL AT 2LT KASOMAHU AND FORCEFULLY REMOVED HIM FROM THE VEHICLE. BY THEN, THE OTHER VEHICLES ALONG WITH THE TROOPS, MOVED TOWARDS THE

SHAGASHA MALAWI CAMP. DURING THE EVENTS, SSGT NUNDWE MANAGED TO ESCAPE ON FOOT TOWARDS THE SHAGASHA CAMP.

- E. THE GENDARMERIE, THE RPA LO WITH HIS SOLDIERS BROUGHT 2LT KASOMAHU AND THE 8 MALAWI SOLDIERS TO THE GENDARMERIE HQ AT KAMEMBE CELL WHERE THEY WERE ALL DETAINED. THE WOUNDED MALAWI PERSONNEL WERE ATTENDED TO BY THE MEDICAL ASSISTANT OF THE GENDARMERIE. THE MALAWI SOLDIERS WERE IN NO WAY MALTREATED OR SUBJECTED TO ANY TYPE OF INTERROGATION.
- F. AT 1420 HRS, THE MALAWI HQ CONTACTED THE MILOB HQ SECTOR 4 TO INFORM THEM OF THE INCIDENT THAT HAD JUST TAKEN PLACE. THE MILOB SECTOR COMMANDER ALONG WITH THE OPERATIONS OFFICER WENT IMMEDIATELY TO THE SITE OF THE INCIDENT (GR 805253) AND THEN PROCEEDED TO THE GENDARMERIE HQ WHERE THE MALAWI SOLDIERS AND THE TWO WOUNDED WERE DETAINED. INITIALLY, THE SECTOR COMMANDER OR ANY OTHER OFFICER, INCLUDING UNCIVPOL, WERE NOT AUTHORIZED TO ENTER THE GENDARMERIE WHERE THE SOLDIERS WERE ALL DETAINED. AFTER APPROX 10-15 MINUTES OF HEATED DISCUSSION, THE MILOB SECTOR COMMANDER WAS PERMITTED TO ENTER. LT PRIVAT THEREAFTER GAVE THE DETAILS OF THE INCIDENT. AT APPROX 1500 HRS, THE SITUATION BECAME VERY TENSE AND THE SECTOR COMMANDER ARGUED THAT TO DEFUSE THE SITUATION, THE RPA HAD TO GIVE HIM THE MALAWI SOLDIERS. BY THIS TIME, THE MALAWI COMPANY HAD REACHED A HIGH STATE OF READINESS. LT PRIVAT ADVISED THE SECTOR COMMANDER THAT HE HAD NOT THE AUTHORITY TO RELEASE THE MALAWI SOLDIERS. THIS AUTHORIZATION HAD TO COME FROM KIGALI. AT 1530 HRS, TWO APCs OF MALAWI COMPANY UNDER THE COMMAND OF LT SIYAVWE HAD ARRIVED ON THE SCENE WITH MACHINE GUNS AND AMMUNITION, TRAINED AT THE GENDARMERIE HQ. THERE WAS ONE COMPANY OF RPA ALREADY DEPLOYED AROUND THE AREA OF THE GENDARMERIE AND THE MALAWI CONTINGENT HAD THEIR WEAPONS ALREADY LOADED. CAPT CHARLES RUGIRA HAD GIVEN

THE SIGNAL FOR THE RPA TO LOAD THEIR WEAPONS AND FIRE AT THE MALAWI VEHICLE WHERE LT SILAVWE WAS LOCATED. ON INSTRUCTION FROM THE MILOB SECTOR COMMANDER THE MALAWI VEHICLE RETURNED TO SHAGASHA. THE OBEDIENCE BY LT SILAVWE WAS IMPLICIT.

NOTE: THE RPA AND GENDARMERIE WERE ADAMANT FOR THE SITUATION TO ESCALATE INTO AN EXCHANGE OF FIRE FOR REASONS UNKNOWN.

- G. AFTER SOME NEGOTIATION, CAPT CHARLES RUGIRA CAME TO SHAGASHA ALONG WITH THE SECTOR COMMANDER TO SPEAK TO HIS SUPERIORS WITH THE AIM OF DEFUZZING THE SITUATION. HE SPOKE WITH HIS SUPERIORS WHO GAVE HIM THE AUTHORITY TO HAND OVER THE MALAWI SOLDIERS TO THE MILOBS IN RETURN FOR A MILOB SIGNATURE AND ASSURANCES GIVEN THAT THE SITUATION IS UNDER CONTROL. THE TWO INJURED SOLDIERS WERE EVACUATED TO THE GIHUNDWE HOSPITAL AT 1500 HRS.

2. FROM THE INVESTIGATION, THE FOLLOWING FACTS EMERGED;


- A. A TRAFFIC VIOLATION WAS COMMITTED BY A MALAWI COMPANY SOLDIER (SSGT NUNDWE);
- B. SSGT NUNDWE WHO WAS THE DRIVER, LEFT THE SCENE OF THE TRAFFIC VIOLATION AND SPED AWAY WITHOUT ANY AUTHORIZATION OR ORDER FROM 2LT KASOMAHU. REPORTEDLY THE SSGT WAS HIGHLY INTOXICATED;
- C. ANOTHER OFFENCE WAS COMMITTED BY BREAKING THROUGH THE BARRIER AT THE KAMEMBE CHECK POINT;
- D. PURSUIT WAS GIVEN FROM THE KAMEMBE MARKET BY RPA AND GENDARMERIE COMMANDER (LT GAKWYA);
- E. THE SOLDIERS WERE SHOT WHEN THEY WERE STOPPED AND FIRED

UPON AT CLOSE RANGE: ONE PISTOL SHOT BY LT GÉRALD NTARUGERA, RPA LO AND ONE AK-47 SHOT BY AN RPA SOLDIER;

- F. THE SITUATION WAS ESCALATED BY THE ARRIVAL OF REINFORCEMENTS ON THE SCENE, SENT BY THE OFFICIATING COMPANY COMMANDER WHO DEPLOYED HEAVILY ARMED TROOPS ON THE SCENE OF THE INCIDENT AND AT THE GENDARMERIE HQ; AND
- G. THE PERSONNEL RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ESCALATION OF THE SITUATION CAN BE IDENTIFIED FROM THE EVENTS NARRATED ABOVE.

3. THE VEHICLES WERE RELEASED FROM RPA CUSTODY AT APPROX 1700 HRS FOLLOWED BY THE RELEASE OF THE MALAWI SOLDIERS AT 1855 HRS. PRESENTLY, THE WOUNDED SOLDIERS ARE RESTING COMFORTABLY AT THE GIHUNDWE HOSPITAL AFTER SURGERY TO REMOVE BULLET(S) FROM THE TWO WOUNDED SOLDIERS. THEIR CONDITION IS STABLE AND THE MALAWI MEDICAL OFFICER IS IN ATTENDANCE. AT APPROX 1700 HRS, THE MALAWI COMPANY WAS STOOD DOWN AT THE REQUEST OF MILOBS TO DEFUZE THE SITUATION.

4. THIS REPORT WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE DFC/CMO ON HIS VISIT TO MALAWI COMPANY ON SAT, 5 AUG AS WELL AS ANY QUERIES WHICH MAY ARISE FROM THIS DISCUSSION WILL BE CLARIFIED IN SUBSEQUENT REPORTS.

POLITICAL ACTIVITY SITREP REPORTS, ON 15 MAR 95, THAT THE RWANDAN PRIME MINISTER, MR FAUSTIN TWAGIRAMUNGA, SENT A MESSAGE OF CONDOLENCE TO HIS BURUNDIAN COUNTERPART, MR ANTOINE NDUWAYO, FOLLOWING THE ASSASSINATION OF THE LATE ERNEST KABUSHEMEYE, THE BURUNDIAN MINISTER FOR MINES AND INDUSTRIES.

FORCE COMD AMA REPORTS, ON 15 MAR 95, THAT DURING THE FORCE COMD'S MORNING SESSION WITH HIS SENIOR STAFF, HE ADVISED THEM THAT IN EARLY APRIL, HE WILL MEET WITH THE VICE PRESIDENT TO REVIEW THE MANDATE OF UNAMIR.
