To: Dr. Linner

At your next meeting with Kabangi you may wish to refer to the situation in Eastern Kasai and to UN actions taken to prevent Kalonji's aggressive moves and to obtain the withdrawal of the Lusanbo para-commandos who mix into politics and exercise a bad influence on the security in the area.

You may also wish to tell him that we are giving first priority to reopening road communications between the Lomami area and Luluabourg but that a resumption of normal flow of supplies also depends on the availability of civilian trucks, many of which were confiscated by the Army. This last point is of course a matter to be dealt with by the Congolese authorities themselves.

(Alois Kabangi is the President designated of the Lomami State).

Storage of Refugee Supplies

Having found out somewhat belatedly that my office is expected to move its present warehouse space from Cenwarren to some other location, as yet to be found, I have gone into this matter to see whether I could oblige without endangering in any way the efficiency of the Refugee Relief Operation which, as you know, still has top priority.

I have examined the alternative accommodation suggested and find that :

- (a) The warehouses have no railway sidings and all unloading of supplies coming in by railway would have to be done on to trucks which after 300 metres of extremely muddy road would deposit them in the warehouse. This obviously means extra handling and extra cost;
- (b) No overhead cranes are available in these warehouses for loading or unloading as they are in Cenwarren;
- (c) There is not enough space in these warehouses for us to place our emergency supplies, easy access to which is essential if we are to be able to operate smoothly;
- (d) It will not be possible to stock on palettes because there is not sufficient floor space and the stocking would have to be too high; there is no telephone and we would thus be deprived of the possibility of phoning through our instructions, an important point as far as speed is concerned.

Apart from these considerations there is one overriding consideration. We have received a very considerable quantity of donations in kind a good deal of which has arrived in very poor condition and needs to be repacked. We have sixty men on this job at present every day and it is anticipated that the

job of re-conditioning these supplies will take another month. This work requires a lot of space which is not available in the alternative accommodation offered to us. Also, any move of these supplies would involve considerable losses for which I should not like to be held responsible.

Not having been informed of the background for the reason for these moves, I can only go by what I have picked up by way of the "grape vine" and I must say that what little information I have would not seem to indicate that the trouble and the expense involved in such a move would be at all justified.

You may know that I expect our present emergency operation to last for another two months or so at the end of which period there may well be considerable changes in the operation, as well as considerable changes in our needs for storage. It is, therefore, my suggestion that this matter be reconsidered say in early July. I would, however, suggest that at that time I will be consulted before the matter is taken too far. I wish to assure you, although I hope it is unnecessary, that I am most willing to help in solving other people's problems. However, you will also appreciate that I cannot do this at the expense of an operation, the importance of a smooth continuation of which has recently been the subject of a message from the Secretary General to President Kasa-Vubu.
