2. Secretarial support. Per Mr. Dayal's cable to Mr. Nabulsi (copy attached), for Ms. Letellier, an IBM Selectric II typewriter has already been set up in a specially designated room in one of the two guest houses prepared by the Government for the SG's visit. We have added two more typewriters and basic supplies and have two secretaries ready to report for duty to Ms. Letellier at your instruction.

Their names are Vinnette Forbes, on detail to ESCWA from DTCD in New York -- English, and Nawal Abla, an international General Service staff member -- *Arabic*.

If I do not settle this with you at the airport, please call me and let me know if and when you may want them to report for duty. They both have special clearance from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to access the guest houses.

3. Translating Services. Should you need any documents or speeches translated, we have both English-Arabic and Arabic-English translators in Conferences Services. No official simultaneous interpretation service, but the language staff is excellent and can certainly assist in interpretation, should you need a U.N. staff member present.

4. Transportation. Although the Government will make available to you cars and all other facilities, we, of course, stand ready to provide you with any additional private means of transportation you may want.

5. Office space. We have set up adequate office space and secretarial/communications support for any of you who may prefer to work out of ESCWA.

For any of the above, just get in touch with me, or, of course, with Mr. Nabulsi, if you prefer.

No need to add how much everyone here and among the other UN agencies hopes the Secretary-General will find the time to spend some time with us. We have the facilities to accommodate everyone in ESCWA so that one meeting can cover all UN staff. This is probably the only major duty station we have in the Secretariat under particular pressure; the past year has not been easy and the future is not clear. A word of encouragement -- or just a presence -- will help a lot. But I do not need to tell you this.

Also, the staff may want to express its gratitude for the swift and generous assistance we received last year from Headquarters when it was time to relocate the families of the International General Service staff who were concentrated in two particularly vulnerable buildings.

Anyway -- let us know.

TALKING POINTS
(Baghdad, 14 September 1987)

Handled over
to Iraqi officials
on 14 evening

1. The underlying basis of the talks was the question of implementation of the provisions of resolution 598 in an integrated approach.
2. The Secretary-General consistently maintained the position that in the process of implementation of resolution 598 the observance of a cease-fire must be a first step.
3. The Iranian side maintained that the provision for the determination of the responsibility for the conflict was of the highest priority for them.
4. While the talks addressed the implementation of all the provisions of the resolution, the question of the linkage between the cease-fire and the determination of responsibility in the context of an integrated approach became the central issue for the Iranian side.
5. When asked to elaborate on possible modalities for the linkage, the Iranian side took the position that the identification process would have to precede the declaration of a formal cease-fire.
6. The Secretary-General stressed that the implementation process must begin on a date to be agreed upon by the two sides with the least possible delay. The Iranian side indicated concurrence with this while maintaining their position described above.
7. In sum, the position of the Iranian Government is that they are prepared to implement resolution 598 in an integrated manner provided that the identification

of the responsibility for the conflict precedes the declaration of a formal cease-fire. This is the essence of the Iranian position as it emerged after many hours of discussions with the Foreign Minister, the Prime Minister, the President, and the Speaker of the Parliament of Iran.

8. The Secretary-General intends to report accurately and in more detail to the Security Council on his talks in Tehran and those to be held in Baghdad. He will then await further guidance from the Council, whether to proceed further with discussions with Iran on the implementation of resolution 598.
