My dear Mrs. Parkin :


I should like to apply, under the terms of our UNRRA agreement, for gasoline and oil for a jeep that is being used for trips relating to official YMCA business; in particular for servicing our camp at Salamis. The jeep, recently purchased from AMFOGE, is owned by the YMCA.

We would like to secure the gasoline and oil from Region "A" garage where UNRRA jeep No. 108- already allocated to the YMCA is now stored. This UNRRA jeep is, however, in poor condition and is not dependable for out of town trips.

The AMFOGE jeep is in good condition and will be used for country driving. We would want to replace the letters AMFOGE with GM- although the jeep would remain the property of the YMCA. Mr. Moulton, my colleague in Salonika, is operating two YMCA owned jeeps under this arrangement.

Mr. Bell, the Transport officer for Region "A" tells me that he will make the necessary arrangements with the Region "A" garage for the service requested herewith after such service has been authorized by you.
