SUBJECT: UNAMIR MP COY DAILY SITREP

1. This sitrep covers the period from 2359 hrs, 30 Dec 94 to 2359 hrs 31 Dec 94:

- a. MISC - CLOSE PROTECTION
UN MP COY continues to provided close protection for Mr ELISANE MAJAMBERE at a secure location.
- b. PRIVATE PROPERTY - ACCIDENTAL DAMAGE
At about 0930 hrs, 31 Dec 94, Mr Allexis NIAYAMBA attended UN MP Coy and reported that the windshield on his Mitsubishi car, licence plate BD8795 had been broken by UNAMIR soldiers in front of Amohoro Stadium, Kigali, Rwanda. The vehicle was parked at the time of the incident and Mr NIAYAMBA stated that the soldiers threw rocks at his car. MP patrol attended and identified the gate guards at Amohoro stadium as Cpl HOWLETT and Cpl CALIS. Investigation is continuing.

c. MISC - REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE

At about 1945 hrs, 31 Dec 94, a report was received that two NGO vehicles had been involved in a traffic accident on Boul de la Justice, near NYAMIRAMBO Mosque, Kigali, Rwanda. The NGOs requested assistance from MP as they were having a problem with some local persons. Situation resolved prior to MP arrival. No UNAMIR vehicles were involved.

SUBJECT: UNAMIR MP COY DAILY SITREP

1. This sitrep covers the period from 2359 hrs, 29 Dec 94 to 2359 hrs 30 Dec 94:

- a. MISC - OTHER - ARREST OF UNAMIR PERS
At about 0119 hrs 30 Dec 94, CANCON contacted UN MP, Kigali and reported that a UN soldier had been arrested by the RPA adjacent to Amohoro Stadium, Kigali. MP attended and identified the UN pers as UNID M3451 NDIAYE Mamadou, Senegal, who was released into UN MP custody and transported to INDBAT, Transit Camp. The reason given for the apprehension was loitering at a late hour.
- b. MISC - CLOSE PROTECTION
UN MP COY continues to provided close protection for Mr ELISANE MAJAMBERE at a secure location.

- c. UNAMIR PROPERTY - DAMAGE BY FIRE (LATE ENTRY)
At about 1325 hrs, 29 Dec 94, a fire ignited in the supply store room of the UNAMIR MP Coy HQ, Kigali and destroyed most of the supplies held within. The fire was extinguished by the duty MP. Minimal damage to the building. The fire is believed to have been caused by an electrical fault. Report to be submitted.
- d. MISC - OTHER - INFORMATION
Emergency telephones at UN MP HQ, Kigali have been out of service for eight (8) days. UN MP Coy can be reached through call sign 0 in case of emergency.
- e. MISC - OTHER - EXPLOSION/GUN SHOTS
At about 2030 hrs, 30 Dec 94, a grenade exploded adjacent to the transient camp and 6 gun shots were fired into the transient camp located beside Amohoro Stadium, Kigali, Rwanda. All camps in the area were placed on Stand-To and a search of the area was conducted, which met with negative results. RPA LO was contacted, attended and is investigating this incident. MP patrol attended INDBAT and CANCON and confirmed that there were no injuries to UN pers.

Provost Marshal visited the Public Prosecutor in Gikongoro to check on the processing of the 44 persons detained during Op HOPE. Real progress has yet to start but a schedule of visits including one to the Minister of Justice on Mon/Tue 2/3 Jan, and then to the communes from which the detainees came, has been planned. UNAMIR will provide transport and escorts for the public prosecutor to make his visits - which will start in earnest on Mon 9 Jan.

Detainees were visited by UN HRFOR team on 30 Dec and found still able to mix with the other inmates (of which the number has risen to 99) in Gikongoro prison. There are 30 malaria sufferers and 5 with dysentery amongst the total of 143 inmates; treatment is being provided by ICRC. The latter is assisting the new governor's programme of cleaning and improvements and estimates total capacity at about 500 when the programme is completed.

At 0630 hrs, 27 Dec 94, T27 950 315 Cpl EVANS J.A.N., CANCON, Amahoro, Kigali, RWA, damaged some public and non-public property at the Duty Free Shop, Kigali International Airport, Kigali, RWA. SUBJECT: UNAMIR MP COY DAILY SITREP - SUPPLEMENT

1. This sitrep supplement covers the period from 0325 hrs, 25 Dec 94 to 0800 hrs 25 Dec 94:

- a. DEATH - SUICIDE (SUSPECTED)
At about 0326 hrs, 25 Dec 94, Cpl SMITH Scott F, Canadian Contingent (CANCON) home unit 3 commando, Canadian Airborne Regiment, CFB Petawawa, Ontario, was the victim of a single gunshot wound to the head from a C7 rifle. The wound is apparently self inflicted. The victim was transported to CANCON MIR and was pronounced dead by LCol SCOTT, Med Pl Cmdre. The incident is being jointly investigated by the CANCON MP and UN MP Coy, Kigali Det.

SUBJECT: UNAMIR MP COY DAILY SITREP - *SUPPLEMENT*

1. This sitrep supplement covers the period from 0000 hrs, 24 Dec 94 to 0700 hrs 24 Dec 94:

- a. further enquiries conducted by this UN MP Coy have resulted in the location of the UNAMIR Vehicle alleged to have killed an elderly female on the afternoon of 20 Dec 94. UNAMIR Vehicle 3023 has been issued to GHANBATT. Further Investigation is being conducted with regards to this accident.
- b. at 0250 hrs, 24 Dec 94 received a radio transmission from call sign zero who advised this office two civilian males from British Direct Aid were being detained at a check point in the vicinity of the American Embassy , Kigali Rwanda after they had failed to stop for the checkpoint. UN MP COY personnel attended the scene and arranged for the RPA to allow both UNAMIR members and their vehicle to depart the scene before any further incidents arrised.

SUBJECT: UNAMIR MP COY DAILY SITREP

1. This sitrep covers the period from 2359 hrs, 22 Dec 94 to 2359 hrs 23 Dec 94:

- a. at 1450 hrs, 23 Dec 94 UNAMIR 11 was clocked on radar travelling at a speed of 110 km/h in a posted 40 km/h zone in the vicinity of the Belgium Village. Driver was identified and a report will be submitted by this office.
- b. at 1840 hrs, 23 Dec 94 UN MP Patrol dispatched to Australian Barracks to investigate reports of a local civilian male who was brought to the a/m location for protection from the RPA. Victim further related he was arrested by an RPA Soldier believed to be named RUABERI who demanded a sum of Ten Thousand Rwandan Francs from the victim in return for his freedom. When the Victim was unable to meet the demands of the RPA Soldier he was brought to a civilian residence where he was beaten with a metal pipe. The victim managed to escape serious injury and was assisted by Amnesty International Personnel who provided transport to a safe area. Victim is being kept under guard until he can be turned over to the local prosecutor.
- c. at 2055 hrs, 23 Dec 94 an report of a break and enter with theft which occurred at about 1600 hrs, 23 Dec 94 at a civilian residence of a civilian employee of UNAMIR.

Complainant reports four RPA Soldiers had entered his residence and had stolen four pieces of computer equipment valued at \$3600.00 US. Info was recorded at this office and will be forwarded to CIVPOL.

- d. Close protection Security/Guard duties are still being provided at Amahoro Stadium by UN MP Coy personnel.
- e. Routine patrols being conducted in the Kigali area no additional incidents to report.

SITREP FROM THE PROVOST MARSHAL

Force Provost Marshal visited the 44 Op HOPE detainees in Gikongoro Prison and found them all in good health and showing no sign of maltreatment - although they did complain of a lack of blankets (of which 70 have been delivered to the prison by ICRC) and eating utensils. New civilian governor was appointed on 30 Nov and has already started to improve conditions in the prison. Notwithstanding his complaint that food supply is a problem, ICRC and Caritas have made significant deliveries. Public Prosecutor has interviewed all 44 and - regardless of the crimes of which they are accused - intends to start visiting their home communes next week with a view to determining whether or not they have cases to answer. He will start with those facing lesser accusations and has requested assistance in travelling around the country.

- a. at 1600 hrs, 22 Dec 94 while conducting radar on Blvd Umuganda, Kigali, Rwanda Vehicle UNAMIR 7 was observed travelling East at a speed of 93 km/h through the intersection of Blvd L'O.U.A. and Blvd Umuganda. UNAMIR Vehicle was not stopped due to traffic conditions.
- b. UN MP Coy are still providing close protection guard duties at Amahoro Stadium, Kigali, Rwanda.
- c. Numerous routine patrols conducted throughout day/night shifts in the Kigali area. Nil incidents to report.

SUBJECT: UNAMIR MP COY DAILY SITREP

1. This sitrep covers the period from 2359 hrs, 20 Dec 94 to 2359 hrs 21 Dec 94:

a. TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT - ACCIDENT - CAUSING DEATH

Further to our initial report of the accidental death of Mrs Therese MUKARUKWAYA (Sitrep 20 Dec 94 refer) UNAMIR was unable to provide transportation for the repatriation of the deceased until 0800 hrs, 22 Dec 94. At 1800 hrs, 21 Dec 94, Mrs MUKARUKWAYA's relatives attended the UNAMIR MP Coy and were made aware of the delay. They departed the UNAMIR MP Coy extremely upset and promised to take the matter to higher authority. Investigation into this incident is continuing.

b. TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT - VEHICLE SEIZURE

At 2000 hrs, 21 Dec 94, Capt KAUNDA, Detachment Commander, UNAMIR MP Coy, Kigali, RWA, reported that he was attending the "Gendarmerie Nationale" Premature Sector, Kigali, RWA, to negotiate the release of four members of UNAMIR and their vehicle. Upon Capt KAUNDA's return, it was learned that at 1545 hrs, 21 Dec 94, UNAMIR 4879 overtook the Rwandan Vice-Presidential motorcade and all occupants of UNAMIR 4879 had been arrested by the Rwandan Patriotic Army(RPA). Capt KAUNDA reported the successful release of Capt DIVINDARE Singh, UN I.D. M 6585, Lt C.D. KAUSHAL, Klar RAMNASAYAN Ram and N.K. BHASAL Singh, all members of INDBAT, Kigali, RWA. UNAMIR 4879 was seized and retained by RPA until the payment of a fine T.B.A. on 22 Dec 94.

c. MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION

At 2215 hrs, 21 Dec 94, Sgt GRIFFITH, MP 811, MP CANCON, Amahoro Stadium, Kigali, RWA, attended the UNAMIR MP Coy and reported that MP CANCON had a Rwandan civilian in their custody. UNAMIR MP attended CANCON MP Section and learned that Mr GASORE Abdulkalim, 13 years of age, of Kigali, RWA, was arrested when he attempted to steal fuel from CANCON. Mr GASORE's custody was turned over to UNAMIR MP but will be kept in CANCON detention facilities until he can be brought before the local prosecutor on 22 Dec 94.

d. CLOSE PROTECTION TASKING

MP Coy personnel continued to be employed as close protection, on 24/7 basis, at CANCON, Amohoro Stadium, Kigali, Rwanda; and

e. MISCELLANEOUS DUTIES

UN MP Coy provided police and security services throughout Kigali, Rwanda.

SUBJECT: UNAMIR MP COY DAILY SITREP

1. This sitrep covers the period from 2359 hrs, 19 Dec 94 to 2359 hrs 20 Dec 94:

- a. MISC - OTHER - CLOSE PROTECTION
as of 1100 hrs 17 dec 94, one MP Coy pers is employed as close protection on 24/7 basis for the protection of Mr ELISANE MAJAMBERE. This person was evacuated from Kibunga to CANCOM by human right personnel as he provided the disclosure of the identity of twelve(12) persons involved in massacres. The body guard has a radio which operate on channel 7 call sign 7.

- b. TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT - ACCIDENT - CAUSING DEATH
At about 0840 hrs, 20 Dec 94, a white Volvo water truck, UNAMIR 5017 driven by MR Muhamed SIBIGERWA was travelling South and was stopped at the Gikondo intersection, Kigali RWANDA. A yellow susuki motorcycle driven by Mr MULINJWA was travelling West Boul de l'OUA and struck the front left side of UNAMIR 5017 as it attempted to cross the intersection. Mr MULINJWA was killed instantly and his passenger, Mr Egide RURANGWA, also the owner of the motorcycle, sustained a broken leg and several cuts and scrapes to the head area. He was transported to the Kigali hospital for treatment. Mr SIBIGERWA the driver of UNAMIR 5017 was arrested and is being detained by the Gendarmerie.
- c. TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT - ACCIDENT WITH INJURIES
At about 1215 hrs, 20 Dec 94, a white Mitsubishi mini van, UNAMIR 206 driven by Mr Alfred NSINGA was travelling West on Boul de l'OUA and slowed to allow an unidentified vehicle ahead to make a U turn. A red susuki motorcycle driven by Mr Charlie MANYEMANA also travelling West on Boul de l'OUA failed to slow down and struck the rear of UNAMIR 206. Mr MANYEMANA received minor abrasions to his legs and was transported to the Kigali Hospital prior to MP arrival at the scene.
- d. TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT - ACCIDENT - CAUSING DEATH
At about 1700 hrs, 20 Dec 94, Mrs Epiphanie CYAHWEZA attended the UN MP Coy, Kigali Detachment and reported that while walking, her mother, Mrs Therese MUKARUKWAYA had been struck and killed by UNAMIR 3023 which failed to remain at the scene in GIKORO, 30 kms East of Kigali. The victim's body was transported to the Kigali Hospital by an unidentified member of the Red Cross. Mrs CYAHWEZA attended UN MP Coy and requested the body be immediately returned to GIKORO. UN HQ advised and Mrs MUKARUKWAYA transported to the Kigali Hospital to remain with the body. The investigation is continuing.

e. PRIVATE PROPERTY - ATTEMPTED ROBBERY

At about 2115 hrs, 20 Dec 94, Mr Jeff SEED, CARE International contacted c/s 0 and reported being advised by a local resident that a robbery was in progress at a food organization near Petite Kigali. Two MP patrols dispatched to the area and met with Mr SEED who directed them to the Lutheran World Food Program Building adjacent to Avenue Paul VI, Kigali, Rwanda. The Gendarmerie, LCol PATRICK was I/C at the scene and advised that the robbery had been avoided and that RPA/Gendarmerie deployed in the area to locate any suspects. As no UNAMIR connection was determined, MP patrol stood down.

1. This sitrep covers the period from 2359 hrs, 18 Dec 94 to 2359 hrs 19 Dec 94:


- a. MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT
At about 0815 hrs, 19 Dec 94, Mr ESSAIED Abderrazak, UNHCR, Field Office, Kigali, Rwanda, was travelling East on "Boulevard de L'Umuganda", Kigali in Veh #2 (UNAMIR 602). Mrs NTAMABYARIRO Pauline residing at Biubi, Rwanda, was travelling West on "Boulevard de L'Umuganda", on Veh #1(Bicycle). Veh# 1 made an unsafe turn to proceed South on "Boulevard de L'Organisation de L'Unite Africaine" and was struck by Veh #2. Discussion held on 19 Dec with the Gikongoro Public Prosecutor about the 44 detainees taken from Kibeho & Ndago Camps and who are all now held in Gikongoro prison. He is checking on the credentials of commune bourgermestres in preparation for visits to the camps to collect evidence - which will follow his initial questioning of the detainees (to start on 20 Dec and take place at the rate of about 6 a day). He agreed to the prioritization of cases with simple cases (incl possession of a single machete and former membership of the RGF) being dealt with first and to the release on bail of some individuals as soon as he is confident that they are not subject to allegations of serious or violent crimes. Next visit to the Public Prosecutor is scheduled for Fri 23 Dec.



SUBJECT: UNAMIR MP COY DAILY SITREP

1. This sitrep covers the period from 1130 hrs, 16 Dec 94 to 0900 hrs 17 Dec 94:

a. TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT - ACCIDENT

At about 1135 hrs, 16 Dec 94, a two vehicle accident occurred at the intersection of Ave de Lac Mulazi and Boul OUA. A 1994 green toyota landcruiser from Brown and Root driven by Mr Terry BAXLEY was stopped when a bicycle driven by Mr Dio RURANGA and passenger Mr Leo SABIMANA struck the BR truck. The passenger of the bicycle was transported to a local hospital. The gendarmerie was advised and attended.

b. MISC - OTHER - OP OVERTURE

16 Dec 94. Pers from Force MP Coy handed over 44 detainees to the Public Prosecutor in Gigongoro as a result of OP OVERTURE. All evidence obtained during OP OVERTURE were also handed over to the prosecutor and placed in a secure place within the Gigongoro prison. No detainees were released by the prosecutor. The prosecutor stated that the prosecution of these detainees could be a very long process. During the handover, the Provost Marshall and the Legal Officer from AusCon were present and have retained custody of all documents pertaining to this Op. All pers from MP Coy returned to Kigali at 1800 hrs, 16 Dec 94.

c. TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT - ACCIDENT

At about 0010 hrs 17 Dec 94, UN MP Coy attended a two vehicle accident on Boul MRND, Kigali. UNAMIR 1091, a white toyota land cruiser driven by Maj ETKASSAUNDI was involved in an accident with a white Toyota pick up BN7980. An RPA officer attended the scene and refused to allow the UNAMIR vehicle to be towed. UN HQ advised and guards placed on the vehicle which remains at the scene at this time.

1. This sitrep covers the period from 2359 hrs, 16 Dec 94 to 2359 hrs 17 Dec 94:

a. CLOSE PROTECTION TASKING

As of 1100 hrs 17 Dec 94, one MP Coy pers is employed as close protection, on 24/7 basis, for the protection of Mr ELISANE MAJAMBERE. This person was evacuated from Kibunga to CANCON by Human Rights personnel as he provided the identity of twelve(12) persons involved in massacres. His life is considered in danger pending Rwandese government disposal of his case.

b. MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT

At about 1345 hrs, 17 Dec 94, Sqn Ldr ABBAS Ismal, MIL OBS, Kigali, Rwanda, was travelling South on Remera #2 street, Kigali in a Nissan Pick up, UNAMIR plate number 459 when he was struck at the rear of his vehicle by a 1992 Toyota, Hiace Minivan yellow in color plate number BB2825 driven by Mr DUSABE Christophe residing at Remera, Kigali, Rwanda. Gendarmerie and UN Military Police attended the scene. No injuries reported from the accident. It should be noted that

the vehicle of Mr DUSABE skidded approx 16 meters prior to impact with the UN vehicle.

1. This sitrep covers the period from 2359 hrs, 11 Dec 94 to 2359 hrs 12 Dec 94:

- a. **TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT - ACCIDENT**
at 1020 hrs, 12 Dec 94, a two vehicle accident occurred between a CANCON vehicle and an RPA vehicle. SUBJECT: UNAMIR MP COY DAILY SITREP

1. This sitrep covers the period from 2359 hrs, 10 Dec 94 to 2359 hrs 11 Dec 94:

- a. At about 0500hrs, 11 Dec 94, an unidentified Australian soldier accompanied by Miss WINEGA Chantal were returning from an outing when they were stopped between the Russian and American Embassy, Kigali, Rwanda, by Pte KANAMIGIRE Francois (RPA) during a routine identification check. During this time an argument took place as a result the Australian soldier disarmed the RPA soldier of his AK-47 rifle. The RPA soldier reported this incident to his superior identified as 2Lt GAKUMBA Thomas (RPA) and both RPA members attended the Australian duty room to lodge a complaint. Subsequently a search of the Australian compound was conducted and the AK-47 rifle was found in an empty room formerly occupied by GHANBATT. AK-47 rifle was returned to Pte KANAMIGIRE. An identification parade was conducted, however Pte KANAMIGARE was unable to positively identify the suspect. Further inquiries were conducted and as a result Pte FILDES was identified by Miss WINEGA as being the person responsible for this incident. Pte FILDES is being further questioned regarding this incident however to date he has not

admitted being responsible. Investigation is continuing.

- b. At about 1245hrs, 11 Dec 94, Capt KWEKU Henry, UN Identification Card MO 610, UNAMIR Military Observer, Kibuye, Rwanda was driving a Toyota, Land Cruiser, bearing UNAMIR plate number 1022 near the intersection of the airport road and an unnamed road near by Chez Lando's Restaurant, Kigali, Rwanda when he struck Mr. HABIMANA Gerard who was on a bicycle. Mr HABIMANA suffered severe cranium trauma as a result of this accident and was transported to the King Faysal Hospital where he is currently receiving treatment in intensive care unit. Gendarmerie Brigade de Remeka, and UN MP COY MP attended the scene. Later, CIVPOL also attended. UN veh seized by UN MP and transported to the UN MP COY HQ compound pending further investigation. At this time, Mr HABIMANA's condition is critical but stable. Hospital authorities were instructed to advise this office should Mr HABIMANA's condition worsen.
