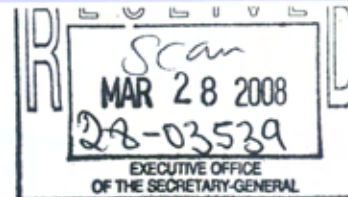

The Permanent Mission also has the honour to refer to the letter, dated 16 January 2008, of ²⁸⁻⁰⁰⁶¹² Mr. Antonio Maria Costa, Executive Director of the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime, informing the Permanent Representative of Finland to the United Nations in Vienna of the decision of the Secretary-General to appoint Mr. Fredrik Wersäll as a Chairman and the following four members of the Advisory Board for a five-year term starting 1 January 2008: Mr. Károly Bárd, Mr. Vasily Ignatov, Ms. Gloria Laycock and Mr. Eduardo Vetere.
